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The Los Angeles County Flood Control District is authorized to construct a temporary detour crossing of Jefferson Boulevard (La Cienega Boulevard) on the Santa Monica Branch of Pacific Electric Railway Company in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application and as shown on the map attached therete, to be identified as Crossing No. 6A-10.02. Width of crossing shall be not less than 38 feet and grades of approach not greater than two per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 4 wigwag signals, to be relocated, and two overhead reflectorized crossing signs.

Construction and maintenance expenses shall be borne in accordance with an agreement entered into between applicant and Pacific Electric Railway Company, and a copy of said executed agreement, together with plans of said temporary crossing approved by the railway, shall be filed with the Commission prior to commencing the proposed work.

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Upon completion of construction of Slauson Avenue Relief, Storm Project No. 84, at this location, the temporary detour crossing shall be abandoned and removed, and the automatic crossing protection relocated and traffic restored to existing Crossing No. 6A-10.03.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant requests that in view of the magnitude of the drain work to be done and the importance of scheduling the work without delay, the usual 20-day waiting clause be waived. For this reason the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
