ORDER RELIEVING DEFENDANTS FROM FILING CERTAIN REPORTS

On August 17, 1954, this Commission issued its Decision No. 50419 in the above-entitled proceeding ordering, among other things, as follows:

"General Telephone Company of California and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company shall proceed promptly to furnish foreign exchange service to all applicants for such service in the Mar Vista area of the Santa Monica exchange. Monthly reports of progress commencing with the month of September, 1954 shall be filed with the Commission within fifteen days after the close of the month by each company until all such foreign exchange services are furnished on a current basis."

Such monthly reports have been filed by defendants and reveal that as of September 1, 1954, there were 540 unfilled orders for foreign exchange service in Mar Vista, compared with 46 as of the end of June, 1957. During the period September 1, 1954 through June 30, 1957, defendants received 1,436 new orders for foreign exchange service in Mar Vista and 1,930 orders have been completed or cancelled, thereby reducing the backlog to 46.

It appears to the Commission that the monthly reports required to be filed by Decision No. 50419 have served their intended purpose, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that General Telephone Company of California and The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company hereafter are relieved from filing monthly reports required by Decision No. 50419.

In all other respects Decision No. 50419 shall remain in full force and effect.
