ORDER VACATING INVESTIGATION

On January 31, 1956, this Commission ordered an investigation to determine the condition and need for protection of Crossing No. B-96.7 of the tracks of Southern Pacific Company by Yosemite Avenue (State Route 66) in Manteca, San Joaquin County. The railroad company advises and a staff investigation confirms that said crossing is now protected by automatic signals equipped with crossing gates. Therefore, cause for further investigation being removed, the order of investigation in Case No. 5718, dated January 31, 1956, is vacated and said investigation is discontinued as of the date hereof.
