ORDER

The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to construct an industrial spur track at grade across 19th Street, in the City of National City, County of San Diego, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 2-272.87-C. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by two existing Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied

with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
