O R D E R

The City of Oxnard, Ventura County, is authorized to construct Industrial Avenue across the track of the Ventura County Railway Company in the manner described in the application and at the location as shown on maps, Exhibits "A", "B", and "C", attached thereto, to be identified as Crossing No. 45-0.70. The entire construction expense shall be borne by applicant. Maintenance costs outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant. Maintenance costs between such lines shall be borne by Ventura County Railway Company. Width of crossing shall be not less than 40 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs reflectorized with reflex reflective sheeting.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
