O P I N I O N

Railway Express Agency, Incorporated, requests authority to transport express shipments as a highway common carrier between the Santa Barbara Airport and Santa Barbara, California.

The Santa Barbara Airport is located in the unincorporated community of Goleta. At the present time the express traffic is being carried by an independent permitted carrier for applicant. Therefore, applicant does not propose a new service, but merely a change in an existing service, which applicant alleges will be faster and more efficient.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Railway Express Agency, Incorporated, to transport shipments of air express as a highway common carrier between the City of Santa Barbara and the Santa Barbara Airport.

(2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service authorized and file in triplicate and concurrently make effective tariffs satisfactory to the Commission.

(3) Subject to the power of the Commission to modify, change or amend, applicant shall provide service pursuant to the authority granted in paragraph (1) over and along the following route:

Commencing at the City boundary of Santa Barbara at Las Positas Road on U. S. Highway 101 thence along U. S. Highway 101 to Fairview Avenue, thence on Fairview Avenue to the Santa Barbara Airport in the unincorporated community of Goleta.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
