INTERIM SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER Walkup Drayage & Warehouse Company has been granted authority, under Section 4015 of the Public Utilities Code, to transport property for Langendorf United Bakeries, Inc. and Hearst Publications, Inc. at rates less than the established minimum rates. The authority is scheduled to expire Soptember 3, 1957. Hearings scheduled in this matter were temporarily removed from the Commission's calendar due to conflict with other Commission hearings in which applicant's counsel was involved. There is now not sufficient time for hearings to be held and a decision rendered prior to the expiration date of applicant's present authority. The Commission is of the opinion that the authority should be extended for a reasonable period of time to allow the matter to be brought to a conclusion.

In the circumstances the present authority will be extended for a period of ninety days.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

A. 20520 (13th Supp.)-JC IT IS ORDERED that the expiration date of the authority granted by Decision No. 53206 of June 12, 1956, as amended, is extended to December 2, 1957.
