ORDER

San Diego & Arizona Eastern Railway Company is authorized to construct an extension to the industrial spur track at grade along "L" Street and across 13th and 14th Streets in the City of San Diego, San Diego County, at the location described in the application. Track across 13th Street shall limited as Crossing No. 36-1.45-C and across 14th Street as Crossing No. 36-1.50-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of widths to conform to the portions of streets now graded with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding two percent.

Protection for each crossing shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting sheet material.

Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended, or if the above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
