Bond Trucking co., by the certificate of public convonience and necessity grantod in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport general commodities between:
(1) All points within the torritom more particularis dolinoated in Appondix B attached boreto.
(2) Los Angeles, on the one hand, and San Diego, on the other hand.

The authority set forth in paragraph (2) above does not include the right to render jervice to, from or between intermediate points.

Applicant shail not establish through routes and joint rates, charges and classifications as to the separate authorities above set forth at numbers (1) and (2).

Applicant shall not transpont any shipmonts of:

1. Used bousehold goods and personal effects not packed in accordance with the crated property requirements set forth in paragraph (d) of Item No. 10-C of Minimum Rate Tarifif No. 4-A.
2. Automobiles, trucks and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger autom mobiles (including feeps), ambulances, hearses and taxis; frojght automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailors combinod, ouses and bus chassis.
