SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 55398 dated August 13, 1957, in Application No. 38829, Western Truck Lines, Ltd. was authorized to extend its service as a highway common carrier to points in the Lake Tahoe area. Inadvertently the certificate granted contained a restriction against the transportation of commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control. In view of the fact that the record indicated a need for such a service, the restriction will be removed.
