## OPINION

By this application, Southern Counties Gas Company of California, a corporation, seeks the certificate required by Soction 1002 of the Public Utilities Code that public convenience and necessity require the exercise of the rights, privileges and franchise granted to it by Ordinance No. 16 of the City of La Puente, County of Los Angeles, California, permitting the construction and operation of a gas distribution system within said city.

A public hearing was held in Los Angeles before Examiner Mark V. Chiesa and evidence, oral and documentary, having been adduced the matter was submitted for decision.
