O P I N I O N

Wilde and Wilde, Inc., requests authority to operate a passenger stage service between the Southern Pacific Depot and the Southern Pacific Yard Office in Fresno.

The proposed fare is 10 cents and service would be provided with two 21-passenger buses.

As justification for the authority sought, it is alleged that applicant has transported Southern Pacific Company employees between said points for many years under a contractual arrangement.

After consideration, the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

- (1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Wilde & Wilde, Inc., authorizing the transportation of passengers and shipments of express up to 100 pounds, as a

passenger stage corporation, as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, between the Southern Pacific Depot and the Southern Pacific Yard Office in Fresno, with no service to intermediate points.

(2) That the authority to transport passengers granted in paragraph (1) hereof shall be limited to the transportation of Southern Pacific Company employees having either origin or destination at the Southern Pacific Yard Office in Fresno.

(3) a. That within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicant is placed on notice that it will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of its operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98. Failure to carry insurance as required by General Order No. 101 or to file reports required by General Order No. 98 in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 98 and General Order No. 101, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

b. That within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public, applicant shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.

(4) That in providing the service herein authorized, applicant shall conduct operations over the following route:

Beginning at the Southern Pacific Depot in Fresno, thence along Tulare Street, H Street, North H Street, Weber Street, West Avenue, West Clinton Avenue, North Hughes Avenue, Espee Avenue, to the Southern Pacific Yard Office.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
