SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Ransome Transportation Co., a corporation, operates as a common carrier of liquified petroleum gases and other commodities requiring pressurized equipment between points and places in the State of California, as set forth in Decision No. 42866, dated May 10, 1949, in Application No. 30036. It also operates as a petroleum irregular route carrier for the transportation of petroleum products in tank trucks between all points in the State of California pursuant to a certificate of public convenience and necessity acquired by Decision No. 47758, dated September 30, 1952, in Application

No. 33601¹

Ransome Transportation Co. has now informed the Commission that its corporate name has been changed to Cities Fuel Lines.

¹ This certificate was transferred from Charles J. Miller, Dale E. Miller and Harry G. Miller, doing business as Miller Brothers. It was originally granted by Decision No. 44362, dated June 20, 1950, in Application No. 31122.

The certificate involved will be amended accordingly. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Decision No. 42866, dated May 10, 1949, in Application No. 30036, and Decision No. 47758, dated September 30, 1952, in Application No. 33601, be and they are hereby amended by substituting "Cities Fuel Lines" for "Ransome Transportation Co."

This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
