O R D E R

The verified application of Union Pacific Railroad Company, filed on July 16, 1957, discloses that the amount of freight business transacted at applicant's station of Manuel during the past two years no longer warrants its continued maintenance and that no passenger business has been transacted at the above station during the last year.

Good cause appearing, Union Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its agency service at the station of Manuel, County of Los Angeles; to continue it as a non-agency station, and to carry on at and through the Long Beach station the agency service now handled through Manuel; and to make necessary changes in all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after reduction in service as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This

authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
