O P I N I O N

Arrow Pacific Drayage, a highway common carrier conducting operations under authority of this Commission, has been adjudicated bankrupt as a result of a petition filed June 21, 1957, in the District Court of the United States, Southern District of California, Central Division, Proceeding in Bankruptcy No. 78818-TC. Curtis B. Danning has been appointed receiver of the bankrupt estate.

In the instant application the receiver requests that the certificates of the carrier be suspended for a period of 120 days after June 21, 1957. It is alleged that the receiver intends to sell the certificates, subject to the approval of this Commission, and it is further alleged that the carrier is not now able to conduct operations.

Upon this record the certificates will be suspended. A public hearing is not necessary.

O R D E R

Application as above entitled having been filed, the Commission being fully advised in the premises and hereby finding it to be not adverse to the public interest,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificates of public convenience and necessity of Arrow Pacific Drayage, a California corporation, granted under Decision No. 39312, dated August 13, 1946, in Application No. 26933, Decision No. 40433, dated June 24, 1957, in Application No. 28513, Decision No. 48722, dated June 16, 1953, in Application 32116, and Decision No. 52519, dated January 23, 1956, be and they hereby are suspended to and including October 20, 1957, provided that applicant shall within thirty days after the date of this order and on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and to the public, amend its tariffs showing the suspension of service as herein ordered.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
