- B. Los Angeles and Vernon, and points within a radius of five miles of Los Angeles or Vernon, on the one hand, and points on U. S. Highway No. 101 and 101 Alternate between Santa Monica and the San Diego Territory, as described in appendix B hereto attached, inclusive of Santa Monica and said San Diego Territory, on the other hand.

Applicant shall not establish through routes and joint rates, charges and classifications as to the separate authorities above set forth in Paragraphs A and B.
