O P I N I O N

On July 23, 1957, complainant Southern California Water Company filed its complaint against the defendant Dyke Water Company.

The interim order issued herein on July 30, 1957, Decision No. 55333, summarized the allegations of Southern California Water Company in its complaint and ordered Dyke Water Company, pending further order of the Commission herein, immediately to cease and desist and refrain from constructing any new water supply, transmission, or distribution facilities, or from constructing any additions to or extensions of any such existing facilities, within Tract No. 3268 or to the proposed school, as described in the complaint herein and in Exhibit A thereto.

Public hearing was held before Examiner Wilson E. Cline in Los Angeles on August 29, 1957. At the hearing defendant filed its answer to the complaint.

Also at the hearing defendant and complainant stipulated that the interim order herein should be made the final order of the Commission. The stipulation was accepted by the presiding examiner and the matter was taken under submission.

O R D E R

Public hearing having been held and the matter having been submitted and now being ready for decision,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Decision No. 55333, issued July 30, 1957, herein as an interim order be, and it is, hereby made permanent and final.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
