O P I N I O N

Charles Grace Enterprises, Inc., a corporation, doing
 business as Meier Transfer Company, is engaged in the transportation
 of property in California pursuant to permits issued by this
 Commission.

Applicant seeks an order authorizing it to conduct service
 as a highway common carrier for the transportation of general com-
 modities between southern California points.

A public hearing was held at Los Angeles on May 15, 1957
 before Examiner John Power.

Upon consideration of the allegations of the application,
 the representations filed pursuant to the above-mentioned notice
 and the evidence adduced at the hearing, the Commission finds that
 applicant has failed to demonstrate that public convenience and
 necessity require that the application be granted.

O R D E R

A public hearing having been held and based upon the evidence adduced therein and the application and representations filed herein,

IT IS ORDERED:

That Application No. 36278 is denied.
