ORDER

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to construct Minneola Road at grade across the main line track of Union Pacific Railroad Company near Yermo, San Bernardino County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. 3-166.4. Construction expenses shall be borne in accordance with terms of an agreement being negotiated between the parties and copy of said executed agreement shall be filed by applicant with the Commission within 90 days after the effective date of this order. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion such expenses by further order. Maintenance costs outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by applicant and between such lines by Union Pacific Railroad Company. Width of crossing shall be not less than 24 feet and grades of approach not greater than 2 percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order 75-B) with reflex reflexing sheet material.

Upon completion, Crossing No. 3-164.6 (Calico Eoulevard) and Crossing No. 3-166.9 (Minneola Road) shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
