OPINION AND ORDER

Belshaw Warehouse Company operated as a public utility warehouseman at San Francisco. By this application it asks that its warehouse operating rights be revoked.

The application shows that the leased premises in which applicant conducted its operations have been torn down to make way for a new structure, and that Belshaw has ceased operations as a warehouse.

In the circumstances the application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that whatever operating rights as a public utility warehouseman in San Francisco may be possessed by Belshaw Warehouse Company, a corporation, be and they are hereby canceled, and that Belshaw Warehouse Company shall cause to have canceled, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public,

its participation in tariffs naming rates, rules and regulations applicable to the operations here involved.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
