O R D E R

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to widen and improve Crossing No. 2-45.3, Main Street, Hesperia, at grade, with tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, as described in the application and in accordance with the plan attached thereto. Width of crossing shall be not less than 48 feet and grades of approach not greater than four per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

Construction expense, except for the crossing protection, shall be borne by applicant, as well as maintenance cost of pavement outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Maintenance cost between such lines shall be borne by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company. Installation costs for the automatic crossing protection shall be borne equally between applicant and the railway.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
