O R D E R

The verified application of Pacific Electric Railway Company, filed on August 23, 1957, discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Dyer during the past year and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

It being found that public convenience and necessity no longer require the service in question, Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to abandon its nonagency station of Dyer, County of Orange; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and the public. Such tariff changes shall quote this decision number as the requisite authority. This order shall not be construed as authorization to increase rates or charges.

Within thirty days after abandonment as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing.
