O P I N I O N

Key System Transit Lines, presently rendering a passenger stage service between various communities of the East Bay Area and between said communities and San Francisco, requests authority to amend its Oakland, San Leandro, Hayward route and to operate over length and width equipment.

The amended portion of the route in the City of San Leandro is necessary to conform to the proposed one-way street traffic program to become effective on or about November 1, 1957. Applicant presently has authority to operate over length and width equipment on its existing route by virtue of Decision No. 52173, dated November 1, 1955, in Application No. 33297.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Key System Transit Lines to operate as a passenger stage corporation over the following streets:

Along Hays Street, between East 14th Street and Williams Street.

Along Williams Street, between Hays Street and Washington Avenue.

(2) That applicant may operate coaches in excess of 35 feet in length, not exceeding 40 feet in length, and in excess of 96 inches but not exceeding 104 inches in width, along the streets set forth in ordering paragraph (1) hereof.

(3) That within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.

The effective date of this order shall be November 1, 1957.
