SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Distance Table No. 4 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 46022, as amended, in Case No. 4808, 51 Cal.P.U.C. 3) provides constructive mileages between all points in the State of California to be used as the basis for applying minimum rates. The table provides in general, among other things, distances between all incorporated communities and various important unincorporated communities.

Since Distance Table No. 4 was last amended, several additional communities have been incorporated. Also, some of the previously incorporated cities have been expanded to embrace within their boundaries previously unincorporated communities which are named in Distance Table No. 4. The distance table does not make specific provision for constructive mileage determination from and to these newly incorporated and expanded cities.

In order to make suitable specific provisions for the determination of constructive mileages from and to these cities, an appropriate supplement will be issued to the distance table. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- (1) That Distance Table No. 4 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 46022, as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective December 2, 1957, Supplement No. 4 cancels Supplement No. 3, attached hereto, and by this reference is made a part hereof.
- (2) That tariff publications required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made effective not earlier than the effective date hereof on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public; and that such required tariff publications shall be made effective not later than March 15, 1958.
- (3) That common carriers be and they are hereby authorized to depart from the provisions of Article XII, Section 21, of the Constitution of the State of California and Section 460 of the Public Utilities Code and from the provisions of Tariff Circular No. 2 and General Order No. 80 to the extent necessary to carry out the effect of the order herein.
- (4) That in all other respects said Decision No. 46022, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
