SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 55602 of September 24, 1957 in the above-entitled proceeding, respondents' highway contract and radial highway common carrier permits were suspended for a period of five days. Under a misapprehension that this suspension was from October 14, 1957 to October 18, 1957, inclusive, respondents suspended their operations for that period. Prior to taking that action, they gave the required notice to the public that their operating authority had been suspended by the Commission. Subsequently, they became aware that the suspension period ordered by the Commission was from November 4, 1957 to November 8, 1957, inclusive. They point out that to require two suspensions would be a hardship. They represent that they endeavored in good faith to comply with Decision No. 55602.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that Paragraph (2) of Decision No. 55602 in this proceeding be and it is hereby modified to provide that the period of suspension is changed to a period

of five consecutive days beginning at 12:01 a.m. on October 14, 1957.

In all other respects said Decision No. 55602 shall remain in full force and effect.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
