Application of THE GREYHOUND CORPORATION for authority to revise authorized urban routes within the City of San Jose. )

O P I N I O N

The Greyhound Corporation seeks authority to revise and add certain urban routes in the City of San Jose. The proposed routes are designated in Appendix A attached hereto as urban routes UR-14.01 through UR-14.08. The applicant does not propose by this request to institute any new service or change fares or rates. Moreover this proposal will not affect the frequency of service or the kind or number of units of equipment to be operated.

There are two bases for applicant's request: (1) Applicant has almost completed construction of a new terminal building at a location different from its present terminal and the authority sought is necessary to permit it to operate from the new terminal. (2) The City of San Jose has adopted certain ordinances providing for one-way streets and the authority sought is necessary to permit operations in compliance with these ordinances.

A public hearing on this matter does not appear to be necessary. No protest to this application has been received. After full consideration of Greyhound's request the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity require the establishment and adoption of the routes proposed.

O R D E R

An application having been filed, the Commission being fully informed therein, and it having been found that public convenience and necessity so require,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to The Greyhound Corporation authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation, as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers between the points and over the routes set forth as Urban Routes UR-14.01 through UR-14.08 appearing in Appendix A attached hereto.

(2) That Appendix A of Decision No. 47907 is hereby amended by incorporating therein Appendix A attached hereto as First Revised Page §1 which cancels Original Page §1.

(3) That the authority herein granted is an extension and enlargement of, and consolidation with, and subject to all the limitations and restrictions set forth in the certificate granted by Decision No. 47907.

(4) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, The Greyhound Corporation shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, The Greyhound Corporation shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to

the public, The Greyhound Corporation shall establish the service herein authorized and file in triplicate, and concurrently make effective, tariffs and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission.

The effective date of this order shall be date hereof.

## SAN JOSE

- \*UR-14.01 - From the northern City Limits of San Jose, over North Thirteenth Street to East Santa Clara Street to Market Street.
- \*UR-14.02 - From the northern City Limits of San Jose, over North First Street to Bassett Street to North Market Street to South Market Street to Post Street to Almaden Avenue.
- \*UR-14.03 - From the company's terminal on Almaden Avenue between West San Fernando Street and Post Street, over Almaden Avenue to West Santa Clara Street to North Market Street.
- \*UR-14.04 - From the western City Limits of San Jose, over The Alameda to West Santa Clara Street to Almaden Avenue.
- \*UR-14.05 - From junction West Santa Clara Street and San Pedro Street, over San Pedro Street to Post Street.
- \*UR-14.06 - From junction Post Street and South Market Street, over South Market Street to South First Street to the southern City Limits of San Jose.
- \*UR-14.07 - From junction East Santa Clara Street and South Fourth Street, over South Fourth Street to East San Carlos Street to South Seventh Street to East San Fernando Street to South Market Street.
- \*UR-14.08 - From junction East Santa Clara Street and South Seventh Street, over South Seventh Street to East San Fernando Street.
