## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The above-entitled matters were consolidated for hearing and were partly heard on June 5 and 6, 1957, and taken off calendar pending certain action by the applicants. Thereafter Application No. 39354 of the Title Insurance and Trust Company and Pioneer Title Insurance Company to sell to Cucamonga County Water District

was filed on August 22, 1957, by the same firm of attorneys which appeared for the applicants on the herein applications, and the Commission was advised that the three applications should be set for hearing at the same time and place and that at said hearing the applicants in Applications Nos. 38135 and 38802 would move for dismissals of said applications. The three matters were set for hearing in Cucamonga on October 3, 1957, before Commissioner Rex Hardy and Examiner Kent C. Rogers and notice thereof was given as required by this Commission. At the outset of the hearing, James R. Edwards, the attorney for the applicants in Application No. 38135 and Application No. 38802, orally moved that said applications be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application No. 38135 and Application No. 38802 be, and they hereby are, dismissed.
