ORDER

The City of Los Angeles is authorized to construct Vineburn Avenue at grade across the El Paso Route of Southern Pacific Company in the City of Los Angeles, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-484.75. Construction expenses shall be borne in accordance with existing blanket agreement dated September 5, 1934, between the City of Los Angeles and Southern Pacific Company. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by the City of Los Angeles and between such lines by Southern Pacific Company. Width of crossing shall be not less than 30 feet and grades of approach not greater than six per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B), with highway holding circuits provided to cause signal actuation on all tracks.

Upon completion of the crossing at Vineburn Avenue, Crossing No. B-484.7, about 175 feet to the west, shall be abandoned and closed.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
