ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

C. W. Scott, A. D. Scott and Margaret Scott Chapman were issued a certificate of public convenience and necessity by Decision No. 52038, dated October 4, 1955, in Application No. 36720. This certificate was accepted by applicants by letter to the Commission, dated January 30, 1956. However, no tariff was ever published or filed with the Commission although time for such filing was extended to and including October 15, 1956. The Commission is now in receipt of a letter from applicants in which they state that they wish to abandon their operating authority and continue to carry on operations as a radial highway common carrier under Commission Permit No. 57-637.

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by said Decision No. 52038 is cancelled and revoked.

The effective date of this decision shall be twenty days after the date a true copy of this decision is served by the Secretary upon C. W. Scott, A. D. Scott and Margaret Scott Chapman.
