ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Decision No. 55704 of October 15, 1957, in this proceeding, increased certain minimum charges effective November 18, 1957. By this petition Yreka Western Railroad Company, in connection with its highway common carrier operations, seeks an extension of time to February 28, 1957, to make the required tariff filings insofar as the minimum charges increased by Decision No. 55704 are concerned. This authority is sought pending a determination of petitioner's separate request to continue to publish minimum charges which are lower than the minimum charges in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2.


By separate decision entered today in Case No. 5432 (Petition No. 101), the Commission granted petitioner authority to publish the reduced minimum charges as proposed. In view of that decision, the petition for extension of time will be dismissed. A public hearing is not necessary.


Therefore, good cause appearing,




This order shall become effective on the date hereof.
