O P I N I O N

Fresno City Lines, Inc., requests authority to extend its Route No. 2 to Lincoln Heights on a ninety day trial basis.

By Decision No. 55616 dated September 24, 1957, in Application No. 38983 the Commission ordered applicant to file an application, within thirty days after the effective date of said decision, requesting authority to extend its Route No. 2 to the Lincoln Heights residential area, which presently consists of approximately 350 newly constructed homes. The proposed extension would be approximately 1.8 miles and would result in no change in fares nor require the use of any additional equipment.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the authority sought. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

ORDER

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That First Revised Page 3 attached hereto as Appendix A and by reference made a part hereof, is hereby substituted in the place and stead of Original Page 3 of Appendix A attached to Decision No. 54331 dated December 27, 1956, in Application No. 38155.

(2) That applicant's request to operate the extension herein authorized on a ninety day trial basis is hereby granted; however, within sixty days after the effective date hereof applicant shall submit data showing patronage and expenses of said extension.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
