O R D E R

The County of Contra Costa is authorized to construct Wilbur Avenue at separated grades over the track of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, near Antioch, Contra Costa County, at the location as shown by map (Exhibit A) attached to the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-1150.3-A. Construction and maintenance expense shall be borne in accordance with an agreement to be entered into between the parties relative thereto, and copy of said agreement, together with plans of said crossing approved by The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company, shall be filed with the Commission within 180 days from the date hereof. Should the parties fail to agree, the Commission will apportion the cost of construction and maintenance by further order. Clearances shall conform to the provisions of General Order No. 26-D.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within two years unless time be extended or if conditions are not complied with. The County of Contra Costa has requested authority to commence construction before

the rainy season. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
