ORDER

The County of San Bernardino is authorized to construct Bear Valley Cut-off at grade across tracks of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 2-41.6. Applicant shall bear the entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 48 feet and grades of approach not greater than five per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B) supplemented with automatic crossing gates.

Upon completion of this crossing and its being opened to public travel, Crossing No. 2-41.5, the existing Bear Valley Cut-off, shall be closed and abandoned.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant has indicated that plans for immediate construction have been prepared and has requested that the 20-day waiting period be waived. The effective date of this order is therefore the date hereof.
