ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct an industry spur track at grade across Erie Street at Old Pomona Boulevard, in the City of Pomona, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. B-512.8-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with the roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding five per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 1 crossing signs (General Order No. 75-B) reflectorized with reflex reflecting material.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require.

Applicant alleges that the industry to be served will require rail service at an early date and requests that the authority, if granted, be effective immediately. The effective date of this order is therefore the date hereof.
