ORDER

County of Sacramento is authorized to construct Citrus Road at grade across a track of Southern Pacific Company near Citrus, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application to be identified as Crossing No. AH-104.1. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than seventy feet and grades of approach not greater than five percent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of General Order No. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 flashing light signals (General Order No. 75-B). If highway traffic signals are installed and maintained at the adjacent intersection of U.S. Highway No. 50, Citrus Road, said signals shall be pre-empted by train movements at said grade crossing.

One year after completion of Crossing No. AH-104.1, Crossing No. AH-104.2 located about 600 feet easterly shall be abandoned and closed. Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall expire if not exercised within one year unless time be extended or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,

necessity, or safety so require. Completion of Citrus Road is being delayed and applicant has requested that authority be granted as soon as possible. Therefore, the effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
