ORDER DENYING MOTION

The City of Anaheim, et al., having filed on November 5, 1957, a motion that certain rates for the sale of electric energy by Southern California Edison Company to the cities of Anaheim, Azusa, Colton and Riverside, as set forth in certain contracts entered into by Southern California Edison Company with said cities, be reinstated as the rates authorized to be charged by Southern California Edison Company for the sale of electric energy to said cities, in lieu of any other rates; and that Southern California Edison Company be ordered to account for and refund to each of said cities all sums collected for said service since September 13, 1954, in excess of the sum produced by applying said contract rates; and the Commission having considered said motion, IT IS ORDERED that said motion be and it is hereby denied.
