ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Petition for Modification No. 38 in this proceeding, California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., requests that the Commission's staff make an investigation of the zone rates applicable to dump-truck transportation from certain Los Angeles production areas for the purpose of determining whether such rates should be retained, revised or canceled. The Association asserts that some of the present rates and zones have become obsolete due to changed operating conditions. Petitioner states that it is unable to secure the necessary data to make specific proposals concerning the rates involved.

The Commission's staff will conduct a study of these and other production area zone descriptions and zone rates in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 7 when personnel can be made available for the purpose. In the meantime, the petition will be dismissed in order to clear the Commission's docket.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Petition No. 38 in Case No. 5437 of California Dump Truck Owners Association, Inc., be and it is hereby dismissed.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
