## OPINIQ

The Greyhound Corporation seeks, by this application, authority to operate, in effect, under a new certificate of public convenience and necessity which would supersede and redescribe all of its existing intrastate operative rights presentiy set forth in Appendix A to Decision No. 47907. Applicant requests authority to precisely define and describe all of its operative rights in the same form and manner as the operating authority of its predecessor in interest, Pacific Greyhound Innes, has been heretofore defined and described in said Appendix A to Decision No. 47907. It requests, therefore, that the Commission issue an Appendix A to this certificate in loose-leaf form, separate and detached from this opinion and order and authorizing it to conduct service as a passenger sbage corporation between the points and over the routes over which it is currently authorized to conduct $f t s$ transportation service, together with the privileges, conditions, restrictions and ifmitations appiicable. In other words, The Greyhound Corporation is, in effect, asking authority to incorporate all pre-existing operating rights into a new certificate in appendix form in the same manner as was done in the aforementioned Decision No. 47907. The same loose-leaf method will be used to describe routes, restrictions, and ilmitations
for the purposes enunciated in said decision. It has been found that the appendix loose-leaf system, comparable to that used in tariff publications, is an efficient and convenient arrangement of keeping the many changes that occur in the applicant's operative rights current. This form of certificate has been found to be easily amended; it has foreclosed reference to former opinions and orders of the commission or to the application in order to determine the meaning or the effect of such amendments. Ihis system has been particularly adaptable to large operations such as the applicant's in which there are constant changes and modifications.

Applicant has been operating under said Docision No. 47907 since November 3, 1952. Since that time many operating rights and routes have been revised in accordance with the aforementioned procedure. In Juiy 1956, the Interstate Commerce Commission authorized and, by Decision No. 54875 dated April 22, 1957, in Application No. 38923, this Commission authorized applicant to acquire through merger the operating rights of Pacific Greyhound Lines as authorized to that company by said Decision No. 47907. The Appendix A to Decision No. 47907 , though correctiy defining and describing the operating rights currentiy vested in The Greyhound Corporation has not, it is alleged, been reissued in effectuation of the change of name of the owner and holder thereof from "Paciflc Greyhound Lines" to "The Greyhound Corporation". This is one of the prime reasons for the request for the present authority. It is desired that the name of the new corporation be listed on all operating rights in the new appendix. In Decision No. 55307 on an application requesting elimination of duplicate authorizations of routes and services, this Commission issued an order that the whole of Appendix $A$ to Decision No. 47907 was made appilcable as expressing and defining
the complete operating authority vested in The Greyhound Corporation and that the name "Pacific Greyhound Lines" as it appeared on the presently issued pages of said Appendix A should thereafter, in each instance and until revised or added pages were issued, be construed as applying to The Greyhound Corporation. However, despite this order, the applicant insists that a great deal of confusion exists within its internal organization over the use of the appendix with some routes under the name of its predecessor and others under The Greyhound Corporation. In order to eliminate this anomalous arrangement and to maintain efficient company administration, the applicant seeks the authority proposed by this application.

Applicant does not propose nor does the new Appendix A incorporate, any increases, reductions, cancellations, abandonments or other changes in the current operating authority of the applicant. No new routes or points are proposed to be served, and none of the present conditions, privileges, limitations or restrictions now imposed or specified is proposed to be changed. However, in order to further administer this loose-leaf system in an efficient manner, certain technical modifications and revisions have been made to the form of the appendix. ${ }^{1 /}$ These changes Include elimination of route numbers followed by the words "Intentionally left blank"; rearrangement of the grouping of the authorized routes and renumbering thereof; the eimination of the tities "Special Restrictions" as stated after the route descriptions of each route group in the former "Appendix A" and of all material stated thereunder and, in lieu thereof, the incorporation of such provisions as may be especialiy appicable to a particular route immediately following the route description of such route. In all other instances where such "Special Restriction" may not properly be applicable to a I. Exhibit 2. Detailed explanation of the changes.
specificaliy described route but is general in nature, the applicant proposes such restrictions be transferred to a section under the titie "General Conditions."

Moreover, the applicant requests that a new section be designated and entitied "Section IV - Motor Coaches of Excess Length and Width". This section will inciude those routes wherein oversize buses may be used and will be arranged in groups according to the separate areas in which such routes are located.

The present Appendix A to Decision No. 47907 also includes a "Correction Number Checking Sheet", a "Table of Contents", and an "Index to Points by Route Numbers". Sheets bearing similar tities are omitted from the proposed Appendix A because, it is alleged, they are not considered essential to the authorizations to operate but are merely informatory in character.

After full consideration of applicant's request the Comission finds that public convenience and necessity require the issuance to The Greyhound Corporation of a new certificate authorizing service as a passenger stage corporation to, from and between the points in the State of California and over the routes as specified in the order that follows. In consonance with the foregoing this new certificate will be granted in the order of this decision attached to which will be Appendix A, in loose-leaf form, setting forth all the points and routes of operation together with all of the restrictions, limitations and privileges applicable. All operating authority of its predecessor in interest, Pacific Greyhound Lines, revised as herein indicated, shall be adopted and issued in the name of this applicant in the aforementioned appendix. Said appendix shail contain all operating authority of this applicant as of the effective date of this decision.

Inasmuch as the proposals made by The Greyhound Corporation do not involve the authorization of any new service, or any request for the abandonment of or any other changes in any authorized service, and do not involve any changes not otherwise ordered in the currentiy effective tariffs on timetables, there is no necessity for a public hearing. The granting of the application is found not to be adverse to the pubilc interest.

## ORDR

An appilcation therefor having been made as above entitied and the Commission being fuliy advised,

IT IS ORDERED:
(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to The Greyhound Corporation, a corporation, authorizing the establishment and operation of service as a passenger stage corporation as that term is defined in Section 226 of the Fublic Utilities code, for the transportation of passengers, baggage and express between the termini and all points intermediate thereto and over the routes as described and specified in Appendix A which is attached hereto and, by this reference, made a part hereof and subject to the privileges, restrictions, limitations and specifications contained therein. Service under this certificate shall be conducted as a single, consolidated and unified operation.
(2) That The Greyhound Corporation is hereby authorized to operate passenger stage equipment in excess of 35 feet but not more than 40 feet in length and in excess of 96 inches but not exceeding 104 inches in width between the points and over the routes as more particulariy described and specified in said Appendix A.
(3) That the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in paragraph (1) of this order is not in addition to nor an
eniargement of The Greyhound Corporation's existing operative rights but is coextensive therewith and ali presentiy existing certificates of public convenience and necessity or other passenger stage operative rights, together with all authorities heretofore granted, held by The Greyhound Corporation and acquired from its predecessor in interest, Pacific Greyhound Lines, are hereby revoked and annulled coincident with the commencement of service under the authority delineated and granted herein. Appendix A of this decision shall contain all the operating authority of The Greyhound Corporation as to intrastate operations in the State of California as of the effective date of this decision.
(4) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, The Greyhound Corporation shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:
a. The Greyhound Corporation shail file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted within a period not to exceed thirty days after the effective date hereof.
b. The Greyhound Corporation shall comply with the provisions of General Orders Nos. 79, 80 and 98 by filing in tripilcate, and concurrentiy making effective, appropriate tariffs and timetables satisfactory to the Commission within thirty days after the effective date hereof and on not less than one day's notice to the commission and the public.
c. Within thirty days after the effective date hereof The Greyhound corporation shall file with the Commission fifteen sets of maps drawn to an indicated scale upon sheets of paper $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ inches in size. Upon each set of maps there shail be delineated in a distinctive manner all routes, by classes, and principal points which the Greyhound corporation is authorized to serve.

Each sheet of each set of maps, in addition to the foregoing, shall also show the name of the company, a designation of the route group to which it relates, proper orientation and other information essential to a clear understanding of the map.

ROUTE GROUP 1
2.01- Between the Oregon-Califormia State Line north of Yroka, and South Woodland Junction:

From the point where U. S. Highway 99 intersects the Oregon-Californis State Iine, ovor U. S. Highway 99 to Red Bluff, thence over U. S. Highway 99 N to junction U. S. Highway 40 (South Woodland Junction).

Authority is granted to deviate frem this route to serve Southem Pacific rati stations at Hombrook and Hilt.
1.02 - Between the Oregon-Californis State Line north of Dorris, and Weed:

From the point where U. S. Highway 97 intersects the Oregon-California State Iine, over U. S. Highway 97 to Junction U. S. Highway 99 (Weed).
1.03 - Between Yreks and Crenada Junction:

From Yreks, over unnumbered highway via Montague and Grenada to junction U. S. Highway 99 (Gremada Junction).

Authority is not granted to transport express over this route.
1.04 - Between junction U. S. Highway 99W and California Highway 21 southeast of Dunnigan, and junction Califormia Highway 21 and U. S. Highway 40 northeast of Vacaville:

From Junction U. S. Highway 99W and Califormia Highway 2l, over California Highway 21 to junction U. S. Highway 40.

No service may be renclered to or from intermedjate points on this route other than Winters.

2.01-Between Red Bluff and Rosovilllo:

From Red Bluff, over U. S. Highway 99E to Rosoville.
2.02 - Between Chico and Oriand:

From Chico, over Califormia Highway 32 to Orland.

2.07 - Between Biggs Junction and Gridley Junction:

From Biggs junction, over unnumbered highway via Biggs and Gridley to junction U. S. Highway 99E (Gridley Junction).
2.08 - Between Orovilice and Marysvi11e:

From Oroville, over Aiternste U. S. Highway 40 to Naryoville, to be operated as an alternate route.

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2.09 - Between Yuba City and Secramento:

From Yuba Clity, over Altornate U. S. Highway 40 to Woodland, thonce over California Highway 16 to Sacramento.
2.10 - Betweon Ostram and Sacramento:

From Junction U. S. Highway 99E and Forty-Mile Rosd (Ostrom), over Forty-MIIe Road to Pieasant Grove Road, to Bear River Poad to Rio Oso, thence over El Centro Boulevard to Gardon Highway to Jibboom Street to Sacramento, to be operated as an altormate route.
2.11 - Between the Oregon-California State Ifine north of Tulojake and Susanvilio:

From the point where California Highway 139 contacts the Oregon-Califormia State Iine, over Califomia Highway 139 to Junction U. S. Highway 299, thence over U. S. HIghway 299 to Junction U. S. Highway 395, thence over U. S. Fighway 395 to function California Highway 36, thence over California Highway 36 to Susanville.
2.12 - Between Johnstonville and California-Nevada State Line oast of Purdy:

From Johnstonvilio, over U. S. Highway 395 to the point where said highway intersects the Califorma-Nevade State Line.
2.13 - Between the Nevada-Cajiformia State Inne east of Purdy, and Orovilie:

From the point where U. S. Highway 395 intersects the Nevada-California State Iine, over U. S. Highway 395 to junction fliternate U. S. Highway 40 (Hallelujah Junction), thence over Altermate U. S. Highway 40 to Orovilie.

3.02 - Between Nevada City and Auburn:

From Nevada City, over Cilifornia Highway 49 to Aizbum.

Authority is granted to doviate from this route to Berve Dowltt Stato Hosputal.

No Local serrice may be romered botween Grass Valley and Novade CIty.
3.03 - Botwoon Blvas Junction and Sacramento:

From junction U. S. Highway 40 and U. S. Highway 992 (Elvas Junction), over U. S. Highway 99E to Sacramento, to be operated as an alternate route.
3.04 - Between Truckeo and Tahoo Vajley Junction:

From Truckee, ovor U. S. Highway 40 to Junction Caldfornia Highway 89 (Tahoo Junction), thance over California Highway 89 to junction U.S. Highway 50 (Tahoe Valloy Junction).

Scheduled operations are authorized only for rendition of sumer-season service; service in Special Oporations may be conducted throughout the year.
3.05 - Between Squaw Valley Junction and Squaw Valley:

From Squaw Valley Junction, over unnumbered highway to Squaw Valley.

Service is authorized to be conducted in Special Operations oniy.
3.06 - Between Cal-Newo and Tahoe City:

From the point where California Highway 28 contacts the Nevada-California Stato Line (Cal-Neva), over California Highway 28 to junction Califormia Highway 89 (Tahoo City).

Service is authorized to be conducted in Special Operations oniv.
3.07 - Eotween the Nevods-Cainformia State Iine aast of Lakeside, and Secramento:

From the point where U. S. Highway 50 intersects the Nevada-Californis State Line, over U. S. Highway 50 to Junction former U. S. Highway 50 (East Folsom Junction), thence over former U. S. Highway 50 via Folsom and Nimbus to junction present U. S. Highway 50 (West Folsom Junction), thence over present U. S. Highwaty 50 to Sacramento.

Scheduled operations between the Nevade-California State Line and Placerville are authorized only for rendition of surmer-season service, provided that schoduled sorvice shall be resumed during the remainder of the year with not less than one round trip per week if and when justified by traffic deminds. Service in Specjal Operations may be conducted throughout the year.
3.08 - Between Diamond Springs Crossroads and El Dorado Junction:

From South Davis, over unnumbered highwey via Davis to junction U. S. Highway 99W (Davis Junction).
4.04-Eotween Migk Farm and Midwa:

From Nilk Farm, ovor unmubered kighways and authorized urban routes for the City of Dixom to junction U. S. Highway 40 (Medway).
4.05 - Between East Vacaville and Wost Vacaville:

Fram East Vacaviile, over unnumberec highway via Vacaville to junction U. S. Highway 40 (Wost Vacavil10).

From East Vallejo, over authomized urban routes for the City of Vailojo to Sonome Boulovard, thence over Sonoms Boulevard to junction U. S. Highwey 40 (Norrow Cove Junction).

5.01-Between Crockett Junction and San Francisco:

From Crockett Junction, over U. S. Highway 40 to San Pablo Junction, thonce over unnumberod highway and authorized urban routes for the city of Richmond to Carlson Boulcvard, thence over Carlson Boulevard to Junction U. S. Kighway 40 (Wect Zi Cerrito). thence ovor U. S. Highway 40 (East Shore Boulovard) to East Eay Traffic Distribution Stracture, thence ovor San Francisco-lakiand Bay Bridge to San Francisco.

From San Pablo Junction, over U. S. Highway 40 to junction MacDonald Avenue, to be operated as an alterrate route.

From Richmond, over authorized urban routes for the City of Richmond to junction NacDonald Avenue and U. S. Highway 40, thence over U. S. Highway 40 to North El Corrito, thence over San Pablo Avenue (U. S. Highway BUS 40) to Oakland.
5.04 - Between North 31 Cerrito and West El Cerrito:

From North El Corrito, over U. S. Highway 40 to West EI Cerrito, to be operated as an alternate route.
5.05 - Between the western terminus of Southern Pacifis tomnany's rail passenger service at Oakland Pier, Oakiand, and the Ferry Buiditing, San Francisco:

From the western terminus of Southern Pactific Companyts rail passenger service at Cakland Pier, over Sevonth Street to Mardtime Street to San Francisco-OakJand Bay Bridge access bishway, thence over routes otherwise authorizad to driention Folsom Sireat and Essox Street, thence over Rolsom Strect to The Embarcadero, thence over The Embarcadero to the Ferry Brilding.

Authority is limited with respect to segments of said route not otherwise authorizod hereir to the transportation of passengers and their baggage moving on prior or subsequent Southern Pacific Company rail transportation sold or provided in accordance with effective tariffs of Southern Pacific Company filed with the Commission, and who are not destined to or from points intermediate between Oakland Pier and the Ferry Buinding.

Only summer-season service is authorized between Upper Lake and Lakeport and betwoen Lower Lake Junction and Middlotown.
6.02 - Between Clear Lake Oaks and Middletown:

From Clear Lake Oaks, ovar California Hyghway 20 to function Cajifornia Highway 53 (Wisitiams Junction), thence over Caldfomia Hilghway 53 to Middletow.

Only sumer-season service is authorized between Clear Lake Oakg and Lower Lake.

Only winter-season sempice is authorized between Lower Lake and Miedietown.
6.03 - Between Lower Iake Junction and Lower Lake:

From Lower Lake Junction, over unnumbered highway via Springs Junction to Lower Lake.

Onit winter-season service is authorized between Lower Lake Junction and Springs Junction.
6.04 - Between Springs Junction and Kiddletow:

From Springs Junction, over unnumbered highway via Soigle: Springs to Myddletown.

Only sumer-season service is authorized.

## ROUTE GROUP 7

7.01 - Between Cailatoga and Vallejo:

From Calistoga, over California Highway 29 to Vallejo.
7.02 - Between Calistoga and Nark West Road Junction:

From Cainstoga, over unnumored highomy via Mark West Springs to junetion U. S. Highwey 101 (Mark West Road Junction).
7.03 - Between Santa Ross and Shollville:

From Santa Rosa, over California Highway 12 to Warfield, thonce over unnumbered highwey vis Gien Ellen, Madrone, Hanna Center School, and Agua Caliente to Agua Cajiente Junction, thence orer Califomas Highway 12 to Verano, thence over unnumbered highway via El Verano to EI Verano Jynction, thence oror Californda Fighway 22 to Shelluile.
7.04 - Between Warfiold and Agia Caliente Junction:

From Warfield, over Califormia Highway 12 to Agua Calionte Junction, to be operated as an alternato routo.
7.05 - Between Verano and El Verano Junetion:

From Verano, over Caidfornis Highway 12 to EI Verano Junction, to be operated as an altornate route.
7.06 - Between Naps and Four Comers:

From Napa, over Califorma Highway 12 to Vinoburg Junction, thonce over unnumbered highway via Pineburg to Junction Califomia Highway 12 (Four Comers).

From Shelivilie, ovor unnumborod hichway via Lakovilio to Potaiuma, to be operated as an alternate route.
7.09 - Betwoen Shellvilile and Ignacio:

S.O1 - Between the Oregon-Califomsa State Line north of Smith River, and Santa Rosa:

From the point where U. S. Highway 101 intersects the Oregon-Califomia State Line, over U. S. Highway 101 to Junction U. S. Highway 199, thence over U.S. Highway 101-199 to Crescent City, thence over U. S. Highway 101 to North Santa Rosa Junction, thence over Business U. S. Highway 101 to Santa Rosa.
8.02 - Between the Oregan-Califormia State Line north of Hazelvier, and Crescent Clity:

From the point where U. S. Highway 199 intersects the Oregon-Caijforma State Line, over U. S. Highway 199 to Crescent City.
8.03 - Betwean Fort Bragg and Cloverdale:

From Fort Bragg, over California Highwegy 1 to junction Califorma Eigsway 128, thence over California Highway 128 to junction U. S. Highway 101 (Cloverdale).
8.04 - Betwoen North Windsor and East Windsor:

Fram North Windsor, over unumbered highway via Windsor to East Windsor, to bo operated on-call for five or more adult fares.
8.05 - Between Fulton Comers and Mari Mest Comers:

From Fulton Corners, over unnumbered bighway via Fulton to Nark West Comers, to be operatod on-call for ifive or more adult fares.

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8.06 - Between North Samta Rosa Junction and South Santa Rosa Junction:

From North Santa Rosa Junction, orer U. S. Highway 101 (Santa Rosa Freeway) to Junction with Busjness U. S. Highway 102 (South Santa Rosa Junction), to be operated as an alternate route between said termini and to or from intermediate access highwys.

## ROUTE GROUP 9

SECIION III - GENERAL CONDITIONS.

1. Diroction of Route Doscriptions:

When route descriptions are given in one direction, thoy apply to operations in the reverse direction unless otberwise indicated.
2. Relocated Haghways:

For the genersi operation of its systom, on reconstruction or relocation of highwass not affecting intermediate tariff points applicant may reroute its operations over such reconstructed or relocated highways, provided that applicant shail fingt advise the Compission, in writing, of said highway and route change, said notice to be accompanies by a skotch or map showing the highways involved.
3. Reginar Routes:

Except as otherwise stated in connection with a specific route description, all routes herein authorizod are designated as "regular routes". MRegilar routes" are deifned as those which are to be served in accordance with published timetables and tarifis of the company ifled with the Comaission.
4. Alternato Routes:

Routes dasignated as "alternato routes" are routes which are in addition to the reguiar routes between the named tormini, and are authorized for operating convenience, to be operated at the option of the company, provided, bowever, no service may be rendered to or from any intermodiate point or points thereon.
5. Routes Within Urban Area3:
(i) The right herein granted, in each instance, to serve named temmini and intermediato points includes the right to operate to and from the company station or points of passenger plekup and discharge within each city, town or community into or through which an authorized highway route passes, unless otherwise specifically rostricted or Limited.
(2) If the routes to be traversed within any such city, town, or comunity are not specificaliy described herein, the company shall use the most direct and practical routes to and fram the company station or points of passenger pickup and discharge therein.
(3) If the routes authorized to be traversed in urban or suburban service are specifically described herein, the foj2owing general conditions especialiy apply thereto:

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(a) Tho urban routes specirically proscribed herein include urban and suburben routes within or pertinent to the respective areas named, into or through which applicant is authorized to operate in connection with, and as a pert of, its authorized antercity service.
(b) As to oach of the areas for which urban routes are specifically prescribed herein, the company may traverse any of such urban routes or combination or combinations of such routes acconding to reasonable operating requirements, and is, in addition, authorized to turn its motor vohicles at termini or intermediate points either in the intersection of streets or by operating arcund the blocks contiguous to such intersoction in oither direction, or in aecordance with local traffic regulations.
(c) The rights, privileges, ifmitations and reatrictions applyine to the operations and service to be rendered over said urban routes shall be such as shail be prescribed by the Commisaicn for application to the company's intercity service to or fram its stations within such areas.
6. Local Service:

The term "local service", unless otherwise specifically modilisod, maans sorrice wherein both the point of origin and point of destination aro at or botween the points so specificd. When the toxm "locel sorvice" is used to prohibit service botween a point, group of points or territory non the one hand" and a point, group of points or territory "on the other hend", it shail, unioss otherwise specifically modified, be construad to apply oniy in instances where the point of origin io at or whthin ane of the speciried points, groups of points or territory, and the point of destiration is at or wathin the other OI the spocified points, groups of points or territory.
7. On-Call Service:

The term "on-call" as used herein refers to service which is authorized to be renderod dependent on the demands of passengers. Such sorvice is not required to be operated for loss than the number of passengers speciried in the authorization of such "on-call" service, nor to or from junction points of on-call service routes with regular routes at times other than when there are rogular schedules of the company arrivine at or departing from the connecting point from or to which the on-cali sorvico is to be rendered. The tariffs and time schedules of the company shall show the conditions undor which each authorized on-call service will be rondered.
8. Soesonal Service:

The term "sumer-season service" when used heroin means that the authorized scheduled service is to be operated between the approximate dates of June 10 and September 10 of each year, unless other dates are expressiy specified.

The term "winter-season servica" when used heroin means that the authorized scheduled serrico is to be operated between the approximato dates of September 10 of aach year and June 10 of occh following year, unioss other dates are oxprossiy spectified.
8. Special Operations:

The term "special oporations:" as heroin used shell, unless otherwase specificaily modified, mean transportation of groups of passengers pursuant to a comon purpose when the fares or charges for such transportation aro computed or assessed upon 3n individual-fore basis. Authority is granted to the company to conduct special oporations between the authorized termind and over the authorized routes hereinboforo dofined, subjoci to the following conditions:
(a) The company shall file and publish tarifis in which shali be set forth the faros and charges to be assessed and collected, or the basis for the computation of the same, together with the ruies and rogulations which govern the application of the same. Such tariffs may provide for nonschedulod special sporations boing conducted on demand and on specifiod advance notice; for the advance payment of a minimum of adult faros as a condition precodont upon which the transportation will be afforded, and for oxclusdve occupancy of the vehicie of transportation by the group boing transported.
(b) Special operations may not be conducted botween points or over routes for which operative authority has not been specificaily granted, provided that when the point of origin andor destination of a group moving in special operations shali bo at a hotol, resort, athletic fiold, or other comon point of origin or clestination within a municipality or within one mile of the route which is heroin authorizod to be served, the company is authorized to pick up and/or dincharge such group of passengers at such common off-route peint when tho same is incirentil to the special operations movement over authorized roites.
(c) The soasonal servico Cofinitions set forth in Part 8 of this Section III, do not apply to the conduct of special operations.

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10. Genersi Express Restriction:

The torm "express" as used herein includes all property transported in common carriage except the baggage of passengers.

No shipment of express that weighs in excess of one hundred (100) pounds shall be accopted for transportation, and aIl express shall be transportod on passenger-carrying vehicles oniy, provided that this restriction shail be further subject to any special ifmitations hereinbefore speciricaliy declared.

The company is rolieved from the minimum rate provisions of Decision No. 31606, in Case No. 4246, as amended.
17. General Southern California Restriction:

No local service shall be rondered within the territory bounded as follows:

Castellamar, Hollywood, San Fernando, San Bernardino, Riverside, Rediands, Santa Ana, Newport Beach, Iong Beach and Santa Monica, nor between any of said points including points Intermediate theroto, subject to the following general exceptions:

General Exceptions:
(2) Local service may be renderod between Long Beach and Nowport Besch and intormodiate points.
(2) Local service nay be rendered between Long Beach, Samta Monica and San Fermando and Intermediate

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points via Redondo Besch and Van Nuys, except that no local service shall be rendered
(a) Between points east of Avalon Boulevard in Wiamington, and Long Beach;
(b) Betwoen points south of Harbor Boulevard In San Pedro, and points in the City of Iong Beach, on through schedules operated via Wilmingtion-San Podro Roed;
(c) Between Garnet Avenue in Redondo Beach, and Conter Strect in Manhattan Beach, via Manhattian Avenue and Hermosa Avenue;
(a) Between Last Hormosa Beach (intersection of Pier Avenue and Sepulveda Boulevard in the City of Hermoss Beach), and points within the City of Reconco Beach, via Aiternate U゙. S. Highway 101;
(e) Betweon the intersection of Waterford Streot and Sepulveda Boulevard in the City of Los Angeles, and the intersection of Washington Boulevard and Iincoin Boulevard;
(f) Between San Fernando and the intersection of Ventura and Van Nuys Boulevards;
(g) Between the jurnction of Alternate U. S. Highwey 101 anci Kanchester Avenue, and the junction of Cailfornia Highway 7 and Alternate U. S. Kighwsy 101, over Manchester Avenue and California Highwey 7;
(h) Between the territory between the company terminal at Sixth and Los Angeles Streets, Ios Angeles, and the intersection of Iankershim Boulevard and Oxnard Street, on the one hand, and the territory between the intersection of Lankershim Boulevard and Oxmard Street, and the intersection of Van Nuys Boulevard and Oxmard Street, on the other hand.

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(1) Botween the intersection of Lankershim Boulevard and Oxnard Street and the intorsection of Van Nuys Boulevard and Oxnard Strest, both points inclusive, including intermediato points.
(3) Iocal service may be rendered between Los Angeles and San Fornando, and all intermediate points vis Hollywood on through cars destined to or arriving from points north of Saugus, or Oxnard, except between Los Angeles and Hollywood.
(4) Service may be rendered between points within said restricted tarritory, on the one hand, and points without said restricted territory, on the other hand.
12. General San Franciscomokiand Bay Bridge Restriction:
(1) Local passengers shail not be transported ovor the San Francisco-Oakiand Bay Eridge, except in equipment at the time being usod primerily for the transportation of other than local passengers. The term "local passengers" as used in this paragraph shall bo deomod to moan passengers transported via said Bridge who have both point of origin and point of destination within the territory bounded and described as follows:

The North, West and South boundaries of San Francisco; the northern boundary of Richmond; Temescal Junction (this point included) and Hayward Junction (this point excluded).
(2) The following restriction applies only to schodules whteh have point of origin or point of destination in San Francisco, on tho one hand, and the territory Temescal Junction-Walnut Creok, on the other hand. On such schedules, no local passengors destined to or from San Francisco sbail be transported fram or to points in the territory:

(d) Between the territory Tudor Junction-Yuba City-Marysvillo, on the ome hand, and Sacramonto, on the other hand, via either Woodland or Marysville.
(o) Betweon points located on U. S. Highway 99E and U. S. Fitghway 40, between Chico and Sacramento, both points inciusive, via Oroville and Robinsonis Corner.
(1) Between San Francisco or Oakiand, on the one hand, and points on the route Marysvililem Sscramento via U. S. Highway 99E and 40, both termini excluded, on the other hand.
(g) Between the territory Stockton-Lodi-Woodbridge, on the one hard, and points botween Yuba CityMarysviile and Sacrauento on U. S. Highways $99 E$ and 40 , both termini included, on the other hand, provided that this restriction shall not prohibit sorvice botween the two above specified territories whea interchange is made at Sacramento with an authorized local corrier over U. S. Highways $99 E$ and 40 between Yuba City and Sacramento.
(2) No service shail be rendered to or from Rosevilio, nor to or from points intermediate to Roseville and Sacramento, except for traffic originating at or destined to points east of Roseville or north of Chico.
(3) No local service shall be rendered between Sacramento, on the one hand, and the territory Port Chicago-

14. General Oakland-Coast Route Restriction:

No local tariff shall be published naming a fare between Oakland, on the one hand, and Palo Alto, Los Gatos or Santa Cruz, on the other hand; nor between Oakiand, on the one hand, and San Jose and Los Angeles via San Jose, both points and all points intermediate thereto inclusive, on the other hand, with routing via San Francisco in each instance.
25. General Through Sorvice Conditions:

At least one daily through passenger stage schodule shall bo operated in each direction providing through passenger service without transfer between

16. Ifmitations on Freo Transportation of Baggage:
