OPINION

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, in this proceeding, asks for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the City of Monte Sereno, permitting the installation, maintenance, and use of a gas distribution and transmission system in the streets of said city. A public hearing was held before Examiner Thomas E. Daly, on November 14, 1957, at San Francisco.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit A, was granted by the city in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937 and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the city equivalent to 2 per cent of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than 1 per cent of the gross annual receipts from sales of gas within the limits of the city under said franchise.

ORDER

The above-entitled application having been filed, a public hearing having been held, the matter having been submitted and now being ready for decision,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to exercise the rights and privileges granted by the City of Monte Sereno, by Ordinance No. 22, adopted July 16, 1957.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
