## OPINIQN

Pacific Gas and Electric Company, in this proceeding, asks for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to exercise the rights and privileges of a franchise granted by the City of Monte Sereno, permitting the installation, maintenance, and use of a gas distribution and transmission system in the streets of said city. A public hearing was held before Examiner Thomas E. Daly, on November 14, 1957, at San Francisco.

The franchise referred to, a copy of which is attached to the application and designated as Exhibit $A$, was granted by the city in accordance with the Franchise Act of 1937 and is of indeterminate duration. A fee is payable annually to the city equivalent to 2 per cent of the gross receipts arising from the use, operation, or possession of the franchise, but not less than 1 per cent of the gross annual receipts from sales of gas within the limits of the city under said franchise.

The costs incurred by applicant in obtaining the franchise are stated to have been $\$ 17.30$, which amount does not include costs incident to this appiication.

No objection to the granting of the requested certificate has been entered. Furthermore, this utizity or its predecessors have, for many years, served gas in and about the City of Monte Sereno without competition. As of July 8, 1957, it served 399 customers within the city from approximately 7.93 miles of gas mains theresn.

After consideration it is hereby found as a fact that public convenience and necessity require the exercise by applicant of the right, privilege and franchise granted to appilcant by ordinance No. 22 of the City of Monte Sereno.

The certificate of public convenience and necessity herein
granted is subject to the following provisions of law:

1. That the Commission shall have no power to authorize the capitalization of the franchise involved herein or this certificate of public convenience and necessity or the right to own, operate or enjoy such franchise or cortificate of public convenience and necessity in excess of the amount (exclusive of any tax or amual charge) actually paid to the State or to a political subdivision thereof as the consideration for the grant of such franchise, certificate of public convenience and necessity or rigit.
2. That the franchise involved herein shall never be given any value before any court or other public authority in any proceeding of any character in excess of the cost to the grantee of the necessary publication and any other sum paid by it to the municipality therefor at the time of the acquisition thereof.

## ORDER

The above-entitled application having been filed, a public hearing having been held, the matter having been submitted and now being ready for decision,

IT IS FEREBY ORDERED that a certificate of public convenfence and necessity be and it is hereby granted to Pacific Gas and Electric Company to exercise the rights and privileges granted by the City of Monte Sereno, by Ordinance No. 22, adopted July 16, 1957.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.
