SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Pursuant to evidence received in hearings in connection with Petition for Modification No. 4 in Case No. 5330, Decision No. 53520 of July 31, 1956, in this proceeding, increased certain minimum rates as contained in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 4-A, on an interim basis, for the transportation of used household goods. The proceeding was kept open to afford the staff, petitioner or other interested parties an opportunity to present further evidence.

It now appears that no further evidence will be offered in connection with Petition for Modification No. 4. Under the circumstances the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Petition for Modification No. 4 should be taken under submission and that Decision No. 53520, as amended by Decision No. 53597, be made the final decision of the Commission in this matter.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

(1) That Petition for Modification No. 4 in Case No. 5330 is hereby taken under submission;

(2) That Decision No. 53520 of July 31, 1956, as amended by Decision No. 53597 of August 21, 1956, is hereby made the final determination of the Commission of the matters and things involved in Petition for Modification No. 4 in Case No. 5330; and

(3) That, except as granted in Decision No. 53520, as amended by Decision No. 53597, Petition for Modification No. 4 is hereby dismissed.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
