ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By the complaint herein, filed on September 13, 1957, complainant sought restoration of telephone service at 2001 Pasadena Avenue, Los Angeles, California. On October 7, 1957, the defendant filed an answer in which it alleged, inter alia, that the telephone number that complainant seeks to have restored is a nonlisted, non-subscriber public telephone.

A public hearing was held in Los Angeles on November 8, 1957, before Examiner Kent C. Rogers. At the hearing it was developed that the telephone in question was a nonlisted, nonsubscriber public pay telephone. The complainant's attorney thereupon made a motion that the complaint be dismissed.
