## O P I N I O N

Bay Rapid Transit Company, presently operating a passenger stage service in Monterey, Pacific Grove, Seaside and Carmel, requests authority to extend service in Pacific Grove on a thirty-day trial basis.

The proposed loop extension would serve downtown shopping areas and link Del Monte Park, Asilomar and other fringe areas to Pacific Grove. Attached to the application are letters from the Pacific Grove Boosters, Inc. and the City Attorney of Pacific Grove. The boosters club has agreed to guarantee the applicant the sum of \$40 a day (except Sundays and holidays), less the amount received in fares over the proposed extension. The City Attorney of Pacific Grove indicated that the City Council recommends that the application be granted.

After consideration the Commission is of the opinion and so finds that public convenience and necessity require the granting of the application. A public hearing does not appear to be necessary.

## O R D E R

Application having been filed and the Commission being informed in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That a certificate of public convenience and necessity is hereby granted to Bay Rapid Transit Company authorizing the transportation of passengers as passenger stage carrier over the following routes:

Loop A:

Commencing at the intersection of Forest Avenue and Lighthouse Avenue thence along Forest Avenue, David Avenue, Seaview Avenue, Stuart Avenue, Pacific Grove-Carmel Highway, Funston Avenue, Montecito Avenue, David Avenue, Forest Avenue, Pine Avenue, to the intersection of Second Street, return via Pine Avenue, thence over Grand Avenue to its intersection with Lighthouse Avenue.

Loop B:

Commencing at the intersection of Forest Avenue and Lighthouse Avenue, thence over Lighthouse Avenue, Congress Avenue, Sunset Drive, Cedar Avenue, Sinex Avenue, Asilomar Avenue, Lighthouse Avenue, 17-Mile Drive road, Del Monte Boulevard, Oceanview Boulevard, Fountain Avenue, Lighthouse Avenue, to its intersection with Forest Avenue.

(2) That the authority granted in paragraph (1) hereof is for a trial period of ninety days. Within sixty days from the effective date hereof applicant shall furnish this Commission with information as to the number of passengers transported and revenue received over the routes described herein.

(3) That in providing the service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, applicant shall comply with and observe the following service regulations:

- (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted.
- (b) Within sixty days after the effective date hereof, and on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, applicant shall establish the service authorized and shall file

in triplicate and concurrently make effective appropriate tariffs.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
