SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Brown, doing business as Brown's Trucking, (i.e., Radial Highway Common Carrier Permit No. 1-5421; Contract Carrier Permit No. 1-8248; and City Carrier Permit No. 1-7455), is hereby suspended for a period of five days beginning at 12:01 a.m. on December 31, 1957, to and including 11:59 p.m. on January 3, 1958, beginning cgain at 12:01 a.m. on January 6, 1958, to and including 11:59 p.m., January 6, 1958.
- 3. That respondent shall post in his terminal and station facilities used for receiving property from the public for transportation, not less than six

hours prior to the beginning of the suspension period, a notice to the public stating that his operating authority under his permits has been suspended by the Commission for a period of five days.
