## OPINION

By this application, filed November 6, 1957, Dave McCoy and Roma McCoy request a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment and operation of a passenger stage corporation as defined in Section 226 of the Public Utilities Code, for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between Mammoth Ski Lift, situated at Mammoth Mountain and Mammoth Airport on U. S. Highway 395 and intermediate points.

Applicants propose to use a 1958 model International 4-wheel drive bus with a 44 passenger capacity. They furnish evidence of adequate financial ability and propose to charge 50% one way and 75% for a round trip of approximately twelve and one-half miles each way. They allege that there is no passenger stage or other service now operating between any of the points involved.

As justification for granting the requested authority, it is further alleged that applicants own and operate Mammoth Ski Lift, consisting of a chair lift and guest facilities, situated at Mammoth Mountain, Mammoth Lakes, Mono County, California, and that it is necessary and convenient that passengers be transported between said points.

- (2) That in providing service pursuant to the certificate herein granted, there shall be compliance with the following service regulations:
  - (a) Within thirty days after the effective date hereof, applicants shall file a written acceptance of the certificate herein granted. By accepting the certificate of public convenience and necessity herein granted, applicants are placed on notice that they will be required, among other things, to file annual reports of their operations and to comply with and observe the safety rules and other regulations of the Commission's General Order No. 98. Failure to file such reports, in such form and at such time as the Commission may direct, or to comply with and observe the provisions of General Order No. 98, may result in a cancellation of the operating authority granted by this decision.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty days after the date hereof.

Dave McCoy and Roma McCoy Original Page 2 Appendix A Dave McCoy and Roma McCoy, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the hereinafter numbered decision are authorized to transport passengers and their baggage between Mammoth Ski Lift, Mammoth Mountain, on the one hand, and Marmoth Airport on U. S. Highway 395, on the other hand, serving all intermediate points. Motor vehicles may be turned at termini or intermediate points, in either direction, at intersections or by operating around a block contiguous to such intersection, or in accordance with local traffic regulations. When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operations in either direction, unless otherwise indicated. Subject to the authority of the Commission to change or modify such at any time, said applicants shall conduct their passenger stage operations over and along the following route: Over a County Road known as Minaret Road and U. S. Highway 395.
