ORDER REVOKING OPERATIVE RIGHTS

It appearing that by Decision No. 45288, dated January 23, 1951, in the above-numbered application that Walter R. McCoy was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing the establishment and operation of a passenger stage service for the transportation of nonscheduled airline passengers and their baggage from the Oakland Municipal Airport to specified hotels and depots in Oakland and San Francisco, and to Treasure Island; and that on May 1, 1956, the Supreme Court of the State of California affirmed a decision in favor of the Port of Oakland restraining McCoy Limousine Service from operating service from and on the Oakland Municipal Airport; said carrier's annual report for the year 1953 contained the following note:

"Oakland Airport service has been maintained throughout the year but due to legal restrictions no entrance on the airport property was permitted. Taxicab and charter service only was carried on."

And it further appearing that subsequent annual reports indicate that only operating revenue as a taxicab and charter passenger service has been received and that said Walter R. McCoy has failed to answer a letter of June 25, 1957, requesting whether passenger stage service is being maintained; therefore, it is found that Walter R. McCoy is no longer conducting and has abandoned said passenger stage service.

IT IS ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Walter R. McCoy pursuant to said Decision No. 45288 is hereby revoked and all effective timetables and tariffs on file in the name of Walter R. McCoy doing business as McCoy Limousine Service are hereby canceled.

The Secretary is directed to cause a copy of this order to be served upon said Walter R. McCoy.

The effective date of this decision shall be the twentieth day after service of a copy hereof upon said Walter R. McCoy unless before such effective date he shall have filed with this Commission a written response to this order denying the facts set forth herein and requesting a public hearing thereon, in which event the effective date of this order shall be stayed until hearing is had and further order issued.
