FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER


By Decision No. 56032, dated December 30, 1957, Western Cold Storage Co. was authorized to execute a continuing guaranty of indebtedness incurred by Santa Maria Freezer & Cold Storage Co. The indebtedness was originally in the amount of \$525,000, but it reportedly had been reduced to \$365,355 at the time the application was filed.


It now develops that the unpaid balance on the outstanding notes should have been \$465,635 instead of \$365,355 as set forth in the decision.

The decision is hereby modified so as to correct the amount of the unpaid balance on the two notes on which Western Cold Storage Co. desires to execute a continuing guaranty. In all other respects, the terms and conditions set forth in Decision No. 56032, dated December 30, 1957, remain unchanged.

This first supplemental opinion and order will become effective on the date hereof.
