## OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No 50075 entered today, we found that the minimum rates named in Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 for the handling of pool car shipments should be increased. That decision also found that, in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution, Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 should be amended by separate order.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED:

(1) That Minimum Rate Tariff No. 2 (Appendix "D" to Decision No. 31606 as amended) be and it is hereby further amended by incorporating therein, to become effective February 16, 1958, Second Revised Page 21-B and First Revised Page 21-C, which pages are attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

(2) That common carriers be and they are hereby authorized to establish in their tariffs the rates, rules and regulations for handling pool car shipments established herein on commodities for which minimum rates have not been established.

(3) That tariff publications required or authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of the order herein may be made

effective not carlier than the effective date hereof on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, and that such required tariff publications shall be made effective not later than February 16, 1958.

In all other respects the aforesaid Decision No. 31606, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
