ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Southern Pacific Company, in this proceeding, seeks authority to assess rates now applicable from and to Marne (Los Angeles County) on shipments from and to specified territory contiguous to the pickup and delivery limits of Marne. Marne was formerly an incorporated community. This community and the territory involved here are now located within the exterior limits of the newly incorporated city of Industry.

Decision No. 55769 of November 5, 1957, amended Distance Table No. 4 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 46022, as amended, in Case No. 4808, 51 Cal. P.U.C. 3) by providing, among other things, a specific basis for determining constructive mileages from and to the city of Industry. This amendment has the effect of providing a single basis of minimum rates for the area involved in the application. Accordingly, the sought authority is no longer required. The application will be dismissed.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled application is hereby dismissed.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
