SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

Decision No. 55226 of July 29, 1957, in this proceeding, authorized applicant to increase its fares. It authorized construction of the fares on a mileage scale, with the provision that fares between branch line points and main line points were to be constructed on combinations over junction points. By this supplemental application authority is sought to increase certain fares by correcting clerical errors made in constructing fares between DOINTS ON applicant's main lines and points on its branch lines between watsonville and Chittenden Road Junction and between Watsonville and Salines via Castroville.

Applicant states that in constructing the fares in question it inadvertently constructed the fares on a straight mileage basis and not on the basis of combinations over the junction points, which is the basis authorized and heretofore maintained. Applicant points out that the published fares are lower than those authorized by the Commission and violate the long-and-short-haul provisions of the Public Utilities Code in some instances. Applicant also points out that the method used in constructing the published fares deviates from that used for fares from and to points on other branch lines.

In the circumstances it appears that the resulting increases in fares are justified. The supplemental application will be granted. A public hearing is not necessary.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that The Greyhound Corporation (Western Greyhound Lines Division) is hereby authorized to publish and file, on not less than five days' notice to the Commission and to the public, the fares set forth in Exhibit "A" of First Supplemental Application No. 38019.

This order shall become effective twenty days after the date hereof.
